

The Burlington Magazine – Royal Academy Free Ticket Draw

By entering the free draw to win two entry tickets to the Liotard exhibition at the Royal Academy and an exhibition catalogue (the “free ticket draw”), you agree to be bound by these terms and conditions. Please read them carefully.

Entry requirements

1. Entry is open to residents of Great Britain, who are over the age of 18, except employees of The Burlington Magazine or Royal Academy, or anyone professionally connected with the free ticket draw.
2. Multiple entries in the draw by commercial agents will not be accepted.
3. You must supply full details as required by the registration form and have access to the Internet and a valid email address to participate.

How to enter

4. The Liotard free ticket draw will open on Monday 14th December 2015 and close on Wednesday 23rd December 2015.
5. Entry to the free ticket draw is free.
6. To enter the free ticket draw please follow the instructions of entering your details in the brief form.
7. Entries submitted by any other means will not be accepted. Any illegible, incomplete or fraudulent entries will be rejected. Multiple entries or entries that are made fraudulently will be disqualified.

How the winner will be chosen

8. One winner of the free ticket draw will be drawn at random within two working days from the closing date from all complete, eligible, properly submitted entries received before the closing date and time.
9. The winner will be notified using the email address provided at the time of registration (or subsequently updated) within two working days of the draw being made.
10. In the event that contact with the winner cannot be made within a further 48 hours or the winner is found not to meet the entry requirements, we reserve the right to withdraw the prize entitlement and award the prize to a second winner drawn at random.

Prize on offer

11. There is one prize on offer, two entry tickets to the Liotard exhibition at the Royal Academy (on until 31st January 2016). The prize must be redeemed by Sunday 24th January 2016 and organised directly with the Royal Academy. The prize can be collected at the gallery before entry unless stated on confirmation of winning.
12. No cash alternative will be offered and prizes are not transferable. We reserve the right to substitute a prize for a prize of equivalent or greater value if this is necessary for any reasons beyond our reasonable control.
13. The prize does not include any travel, accommodation or delivery costs incurred by the winner in order to enjoy the prize. Prizes are subject to the prize suppliers’ terms and conditions.

Liability

14. We reserve the right to amend these terms and conditions without notice.

The Burlington Magazine reserves the right to modify, cancel, terminate or suspend the free ticket draw in whole or part, at its sole discretion, if it believes the free ticket draw is not capable of being conducted as specified within these Terms and Conditions or in the event of any other cause that is beyond the reasonable control of The Burlington Magazine that could affect the normal course of the free draw.
